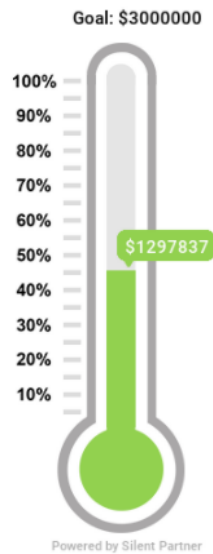

The SCC experienced such great support in 2021! After our initial kick-off with our Board of Directors and Advisory Board, we held a community fundraising event at The Refind, participated in our first Giving Tuesday event, we were featured in a local Capitol Hill Blog article, signed an LOI at Capitol Hill Station and ended the year with an outpouring of support from both individuals and community partners, raising approximately \$1.3 million in year one.

We are reaching for new heights in 2022 and continuing to push forward with our Capital Campaign goal of raising \$3 million this calendar year. These funds will allow us to create a purpose-built center, hire core staff, and ensure equity and accessibility for memberships as we open our doors in Fall 2022.
